The following week, I was waiting in my hospital room with my parents at my bedside when my doctors diagnosed me with leukemia. Since that day in 2014, my treatment plan entailed two and a half years of chemotherapy.

Through my diagnosis my oncologist referred me to Make-A-Wish, and I learned that I qualified to receive my greatest wish come true, which was going to New York Fashion Week with my entire family. My wish helped me in deciding my career path after college, where I ended up attending Fordham University just blocks away from the very fashion shows we attended back in 2015.

Spending a week attending fashion shows, meeting designers, and seeing the runway behind the scenes and first-hand during my wish experience is what inspired me to start looking into a career path relating to fashion. Another added bonus of my wish experience is that I have established lifelong connections with the designers I met. Without my wish experience, I would not have the opportunities that I have at my fingertips.

Flash forward to present day — I'm living out my childhood dreams of working in New York City after graduating from Fordham just over a year ago, and now working full time in the PR industry and enjoying all the city has to offer.

After my wish was granted to go to New York Fashion Week, I have had the opportunity to speak at donor dinners, a golf event, a women's club meeting, a radio-a-thon, and even a fundraiser where I had the chance to meet fashion designer, Nicole Miller.
